


STAYCATION ALL I EVER WANTED

HOTEL MAGDALENA

The Seventies-inspired Hotel Magdalena embodies so much of what there is to love about Austin. Located right on South Congress, just a short walk away from Lady Bird Lake, the thoughtfully designed property includes beautiful grounds (and a 900-square-foot swimming pool) that make it a true urban oasis.

During your stay, be sure to enjoy a meal at Summer House on Music Lane, the hotel's full-service restaurant. Guest perks include a calendar of activities like yoga and live music, and bike rentals are complimentary.




THE OTIS HOTEL


Adjacent to the UT campus, The Otis Hotel is for those who love a bit of luxury without the pretentiousness. The comfortable, tastefully decorated rooms are the perfect place to rest your body, and each one has a vinyl record player. It's not just a gimmick, either, as the hotel has its own "vinyl ambassador" who can help you pick out a selection of records to enjoy during your stay, whether you want to bliss out or rock out.

Another big plus of being a guest here: easy access to the 21+ rooftop pool and lounge. One of the best times to visit is during the Golden Hour happy hour, extending from one hour before to one hour after sunset Monday through Thursday.


If you're traveling alone or you like to spend most of your time exploring the area, the tommie is worth considering.
